



WATERFORD VIKING TRIANGLE

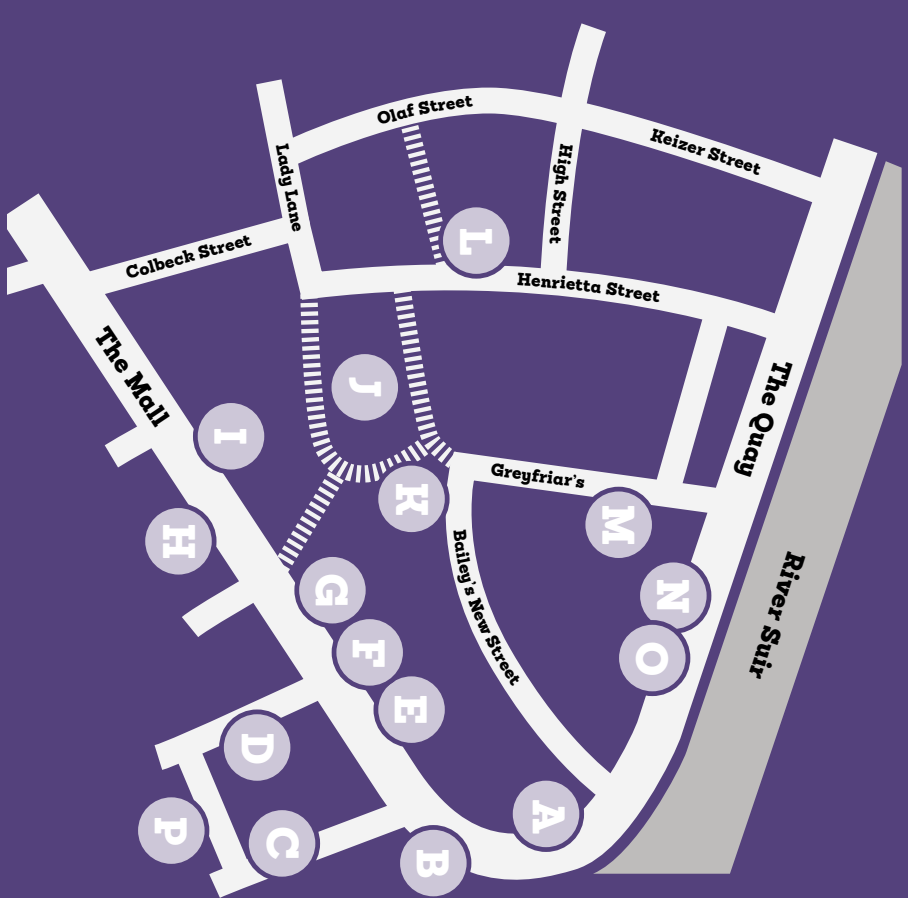
Waterford Viking Triangle is the cultural and heritage quarter of Ireland's oldest city where the Vikings first settled in 914 A.D.

The cultural and heritage attractions embrace nine national monuments including a 13th century underground wine vault and three world-class museums: Viking, Medieval and Georgian. The Viking Museum is housed in Reginalds Tower the oldest civic urban structure in Ireland.

Tranquil and charming, the quarter is characterised by narrow streets, historic architecture and atmospheric public spaces. Home to the global brand Waterford Crystal since 1783, the retail store showcases the world's largest collection of Waterford Crystal.

Over 1,000 years of history unfold in just 1,000 paces in this authentically charming location.
