Waterford Viking Triangle is the cultural and heritage quarter of Ireland's oldest city where the Vikings first settled in 914 A.D.

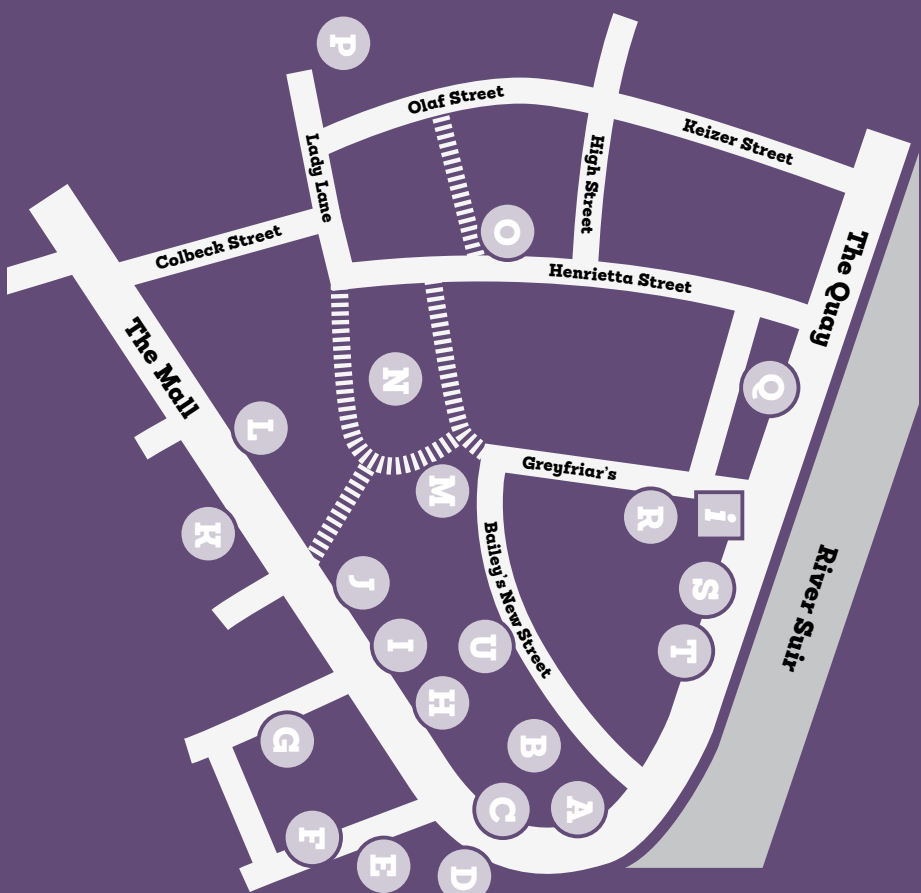
