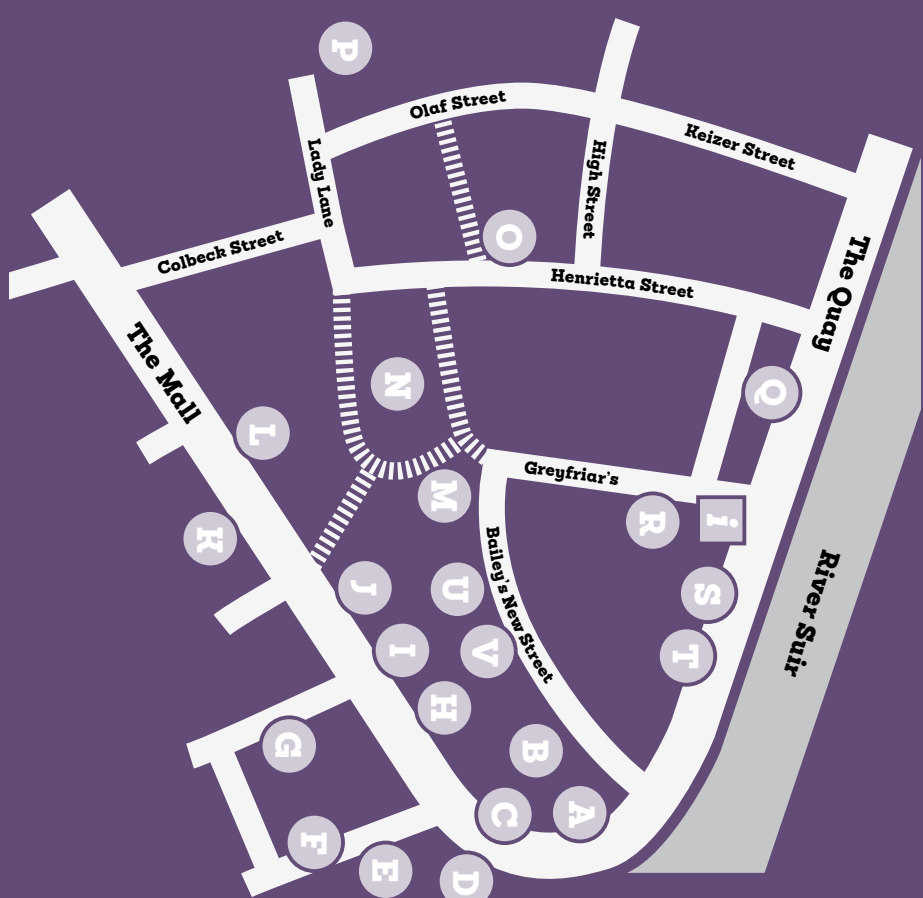

Did You Know...

The little Design Shop is not just a shop. It is a hive of creativity, with jewellery designers, a fine art printmaker, many craftworkers and artists working in situ. It is situated across from Waterford's Plaza on the Quays in Waterford. The Gift shop is on the ground floor stocking pieces from resident designers (stunning feltwork, crochet, handmade jewellery) and artists and an array of work from local and Irish craftworkers.

The Little Design Shop is just a little over a year old; they celebrated their first birthday in April. The little Design Shop was formed in 2013 when Stradbally Jewellery and Anne Mc Donnell Printmaker (previously residents at Kite Design Studios) decided to spread their wings and set up the little blue shop and stocked it with quality Irish handmade craft.

Stradbally Jewellery, are a husband and wife team whose different perspectives marry together to produce a very contemporary style. They take their inspiration from their beautiful coastal surroundings from their hometown of Stradbally. Stradbally Jewellery has one of their workshops situated on the ground floor where you can see the work and detail that goes into each piece. They also give classes from their studio on the first floor.

Anne Mc Donnell has her printmaking studio on the first floor, where she prints fine art handprinted etchings using traditional printmaking techniques depicting images of Ireland, and more recently exploring new themes. She has been on The Design Crafts Council of Ireland's Craft Education Panel for some years and brings her printmaking experience to primary schools in Waterford. Anne also offers printmaking classes for adults, and open studio on Saturday mornings
