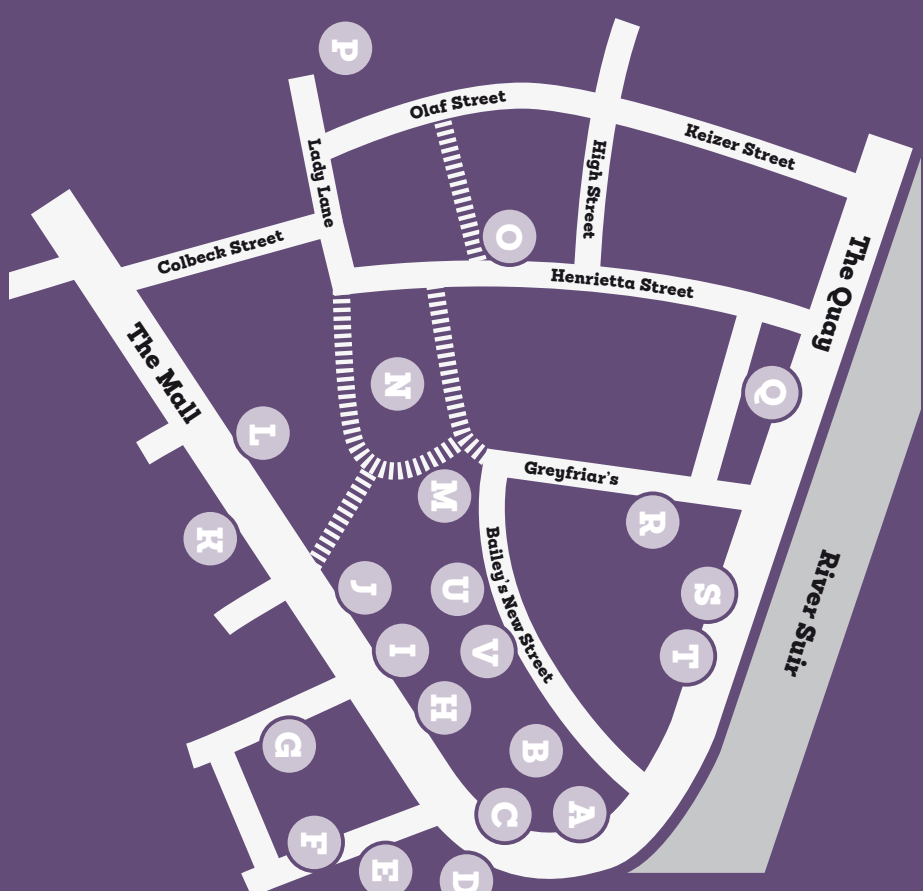

Button & Co. are the creators of a luxurious collection of jewellery based on a nostalgic theme, handmade in The Viking Triangle.

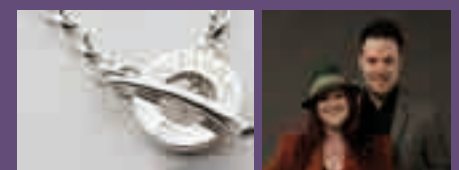
Button & Co. is focused on celebrating memories of times past and creating new memories for the future.
